After my presentation on the SP Exeter Branch, there were a lot of questions about my points system and how it worked. Though I tried to explain it, I thought it prudent to write a document to add clarity and give a demonstration of how the system works with examples. The pages below will walk you thru the process.

In the example, I will show session assignments September thru December. I will include how the process works for existing operators, the introduction of new operators, and the resolution of ties in total points.

I use Microsoft Excel to manage the list

Points Allocation:

- Points specifically represent the pick order for the operator.
- Pick 1 gets 1 point
- Pick 2 gets 3 points
- Pick 3 gets 5 points
- Pick 4 gets 7 points
- Pick 5 gets 9 points.
- Points do not reflect attendance, performance, penalties, or anything else. Just the order of selection for each session.

Precondition: The operators in this have been operating for a couple of years on the SP Exeter Branch, thus they have an accumulated average. This helps to make the example more obvious.
